## Our First Auxiliary President



### **Mrs. Utha "Sally" Deen** **July 12, 1906 - September 13, 2014**

Many current Volunteers did not have the privilege and distinct honor of knowing Mrs. Sally Deen. However, her vision and leadership continue to impact the service provided by every Volunteer even today.

Mrs. Deen was born in Grant County as Utha "Sally" Leola Blackburn. As a freshman at UK, she met and married the love of her life, Encil Deen. They were married in 1926 and graduated from UK in 1929.

Mrs. Deen grew up spiritually at Calvary Baptist Church and was part of a group of women from various Baptist churches who helped form the Central Baptist Hospital Auxiliary. These women were involved in missionary organizations at their local churches and took it upon themselves to help raise money for the new Baptist Hospital that would be built on some farm land just outside of the city. In 1948, Sally Deen, or Mrs. Encil Deen, as she's known in the minutes, was elected the very first Auxiliary President. This was SIX YEARS before the hospital would open its doors in 1954.

In addition to her activities with the hospital, Mrs. Deen actively served at Calvary Baptist Church, teaching the Vita Vota class for over 50 years. She was also a member of the Board for Oneida Baptist Institute, State President for the Women's Missionary Union (WMU) from 1951-1954, a member of the Gideon auxiliary, and a member of Fayette County Homemakers for over 75 years.

The Baptist Health Auxiliary is blessed to have had such a Godly woman with vision to serve as the very first Auxiliary President. Mrs. Deen will certainly be missed!
