New Nursing Student Fellowship

We're excited about the introduction of the Nursing Student Volunteer Fellowship this year! We've selected five nursing students entering their final year of nursing school who will be able to participate in a unique Volunteer experience that will help them gain exposure to lesser known areas of nursing and nursing leadership development opportunities. This program is designed to support the hospital and healthcare system's strategy of Workforce Development.

The Nursing Student Volunteer Fellowship is designed so that each morning these students begin their day shadowing a different nurse manager as she conducts her "Leadership Rounds." Next, these students will have the opportunity to observe several different areas of nursing with an emphasis on areas related to surgery. Over lunch these students will learn some basics about nursing leadership from hospital staff who also instruct in the hospital's nationally recognized "Evolving Leaders" program. Among the leaders, is the hospital's Chief Operating Officer and Chief Nursing Officer, Karen Hill. After lunch, the young people will have the opportunity to spend time with nurses in fields to which they are not typically exposed during nursing clinicals, such as a Diabetes Educator, Clinical Nurse Educator, House Supervisor, and Nurse Epidemiologist. Finally, each day will conclude with a time of journaling and guided reflection and debriefing.
