## *The switch to Quick Books has been made!*

2014 has been full of excitement in Lifeline thus far!

With the hospital transitioning to a new billing system, we discovered the need for Lifeline to begin using a separate billing software. In early 2013, Edna and I began the initial process of transitioning our billing from Louisville to an in house system using QuickBooks. I am pleased to announce that as of February, we are officially using QuickBooks to do our Lifeline billing. The response has been overwhelmingly positive from our subscribers.

Many thanks to Edna, Don, Lisa and our amazing volunteers who have held down the fort and allowed Edna and me to focus primarily on this transition!
