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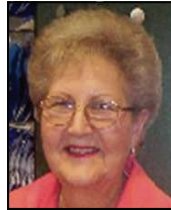

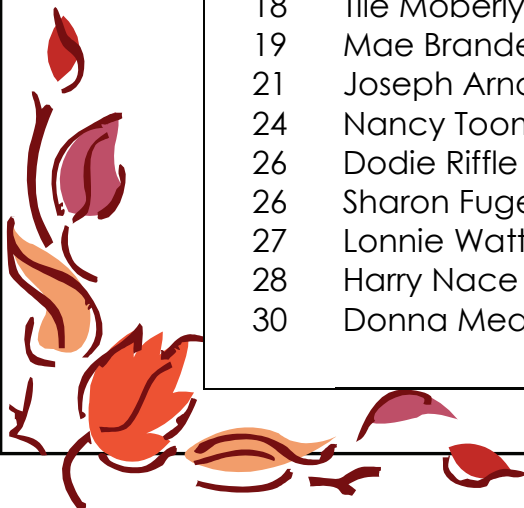

## Teen Volunteers - From Summer into the School Year

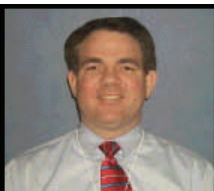


We concluded another fantastic summer VolunTeen Program with the fourth annual VolunTeen Fellowship. We had five wonderful young ladies who were selected for the program this year - Mia

Chaloub, Trinity Durham, Marlee Mirre, Kayla Taylor, and Madison Oxley. They had incredible experiences as they observed in a variety of areas, participated in a couple of service projects, were exposed to key leaders in the hospital and community, and debriefed their experiences by journaling and guided feedback.

And, just because summer is over doesn't mean you will stop seeing teen Volunteers. About 200 high school seniors received an orientation for Experience-Based Career Education (EBCE), an academic internship program in Fayette County Public Schools (FCPS) that maximizes classroom and community resources to provide realistic perspectives. Additionally, we have students from Community Service classes at various high schools. We also utilize Volunteers as part of the Fayette County Public Schools Employment Training Program.
